**HARP need:** coffee, sugar, pot noodles, tinned meals, breakfast cereal, squash, cooking sauces, Fray Bentos meat pies & puddings, cooking oil, tinned pasta, veg & soup: ravioli, macaroni, potatoes & veg. Biscuits, rice, jam, peanut butter, choc spread, cup-a-soup, UHT milk, rice pudding, custard, mayo & crisps.

All can be left in hoppers in church, or taken to a Foodbank collection point, like West Leigh and Leigh Road Baptist Churches.
