Biscuits, rice, jam, peanut butter, choc spread, cup-a-soup, UHT milk, rice pudding, custard, mayo & crisps.

Southend Foodbank also need donations: UHT milk, pasta sauce, tins of fish, fruit, veg, tomatoes & meat meals; dried food like rice, pasta, instant mash. Their clients can cook, but are struggling to afford food.
