Food Donations for the needy— Non-perishable, dried, long-life food can be brought to church for HARP and our local Foodbank.



HARP most needed: coffee, sugar, pot noodles, tinned meals, breakfast cereal, squash, cooking sauces, Fray Bentos meat pies & puddings, cooking oil, tinned pasta: ravioli, macaroni, tinned potatoes & veg, tinned soup. Biscuits, rice, jam, peanut butter, choc spread, cup-a-soup, UHT milk, rice pudding, custard, mayo & crisps.

Southend Foodbank also need donations of: UHT milk, pasta sauce, tins of fish, fruit, veg, tomatoes & meat meals, and dried food like rice, pasta, instant mash. Their clients can cook, but are struggling to afford to buy food.

Can be left in hoppers in church, or taken to Foodbank collection point, like West Leigh and Leigh Road Baptist Churches. **Thank you very much.**
